



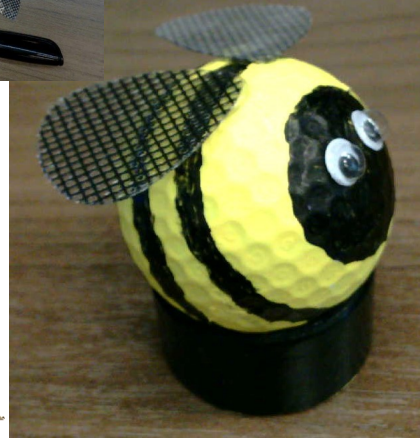
Golf Ball Bumblebee

Supplies included:

- Golf ball
- Golf ball stand
- Yellow paint
- Black permanent marker
- 2 adhesive googly eyes
- 2 bumblebee wings (created with laminated screen & guitar pick punch)
- Paint brush

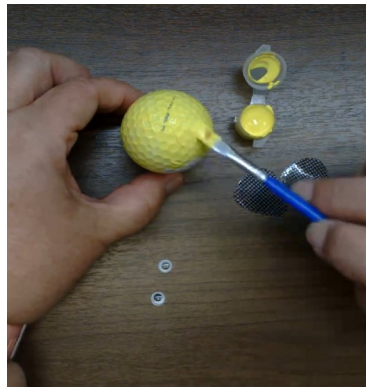
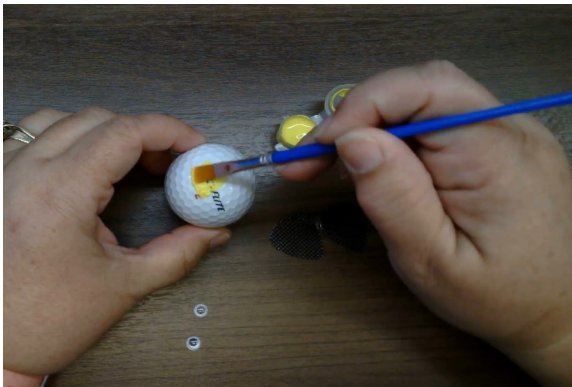
Additional supplies needed:

- Hot glue gun
- Hot glue sticks



Step 1

Using paint brush coat golf ball with yellow paint. Allow to dry before adding another coat of yellow paint. It will take 2-3 coats of yellow paint to cover up lettering on golf ball.



Step 2

After golf ball is coated well with yellow paint and paint is dry, add bumblebee face to golf ball using black permanent marker. Draw a circle on one side of golf ball about the size of a nickel. (Try to cover lettering if it shows through yellow paint.)



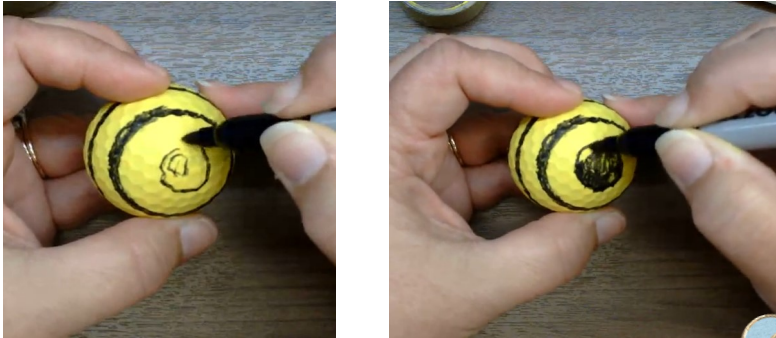
Step 3

Draw two or three lines around golf ball to make bumblebee stripes.



Step 4

Draw a circle at the opposite end from face about the size of a dime to create bumblebee's end.



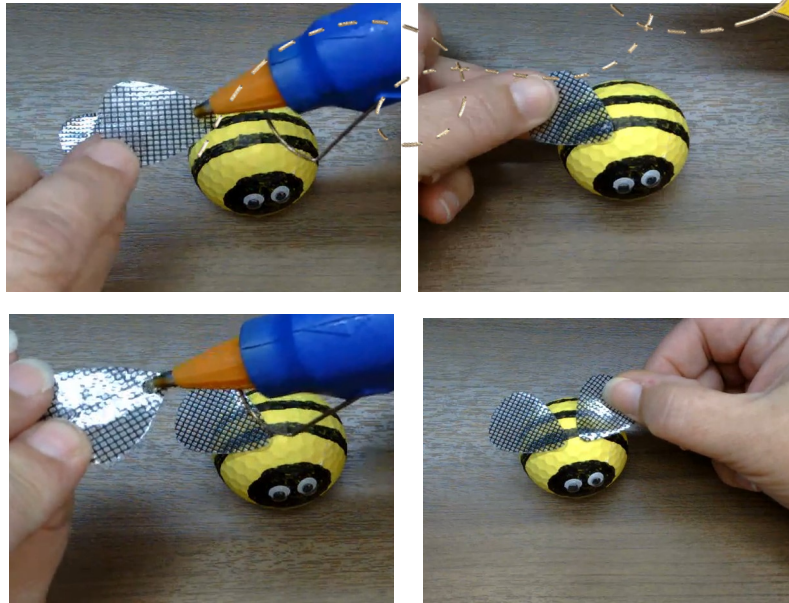
Step 5

Attach googly eyes by peeling off paper on back and adding to bumblebee's face.



Step 6

Attach bumblebee's wings with hot glue.
