

Mother's Day Cards



Supply List:

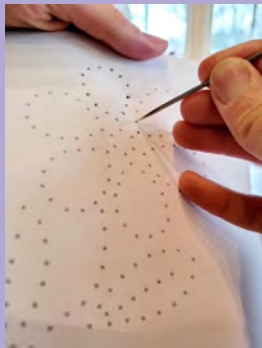
Card templates *printed on cardstock*

Yarn (assorted colors)

Scissors

Yarn needle

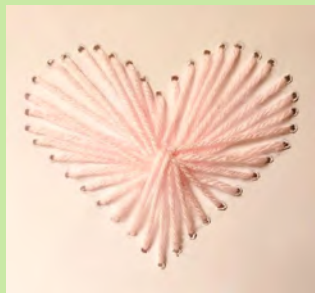
Invisible tape



Step One: These cards are so simple and fun! Begin by poking little holes with your needle where indicated on the pattern. This will make it much easier to find each hole while sewing.

Step Two: To thread needle, take a piece of invisible tape and wrap it around one end of your desired color yarn. Cut the tape and yarn at an angle and insert it into the needle eye. Cut off tape when needle is threaded. Cut yarn for heart and petals into shorter lengths. Tie a knot in the end of the yarn and pull the needle then yarn through your first hole from the back of the image. Continue to pull the yarn until the knot is secure on the back of the paper.

Step Three: Continue stitching around the pattern's dots. Don't pull the stitch too tight. It will rip the paper. There are so many ways to complete each pattern! You can make the outline only, fill with stripes or diagonal lines, or even fan out from a single point. Have fun with it! If changing a color or piece of yarn, simply knot currently used yarn on the back side of the paper and repeat **Step Two** with a new color.



Step Four: Fold your card and write a lovely note to whomever will be receiving it.
