

Supplies Included:

- Brown paper lunch bags—18 bags (9 of each size)
- 2 pieces of twine for hanger

Supplies Needed:

- White school glue
 OR hot glue gun & sticks
 OR glue stick
- 🄻 Stapler
- * Pencil
- Scissors
- * Hole punch *(optional)*



Step One: Make a thin line of glue along bottom edge and center of one bag. Stack another bag on top of bag with glue on it and repeat until all nine bags are glued together. All bags should be facing the same direction, open ends together and folded bottoms facing down.

Step Two: Once glued, allow stack to dry completely. For best results, place something heavy on top during drying to






Step Three: After glue has dried, slowly open bags so they can be fanned out. Use a stapler to reinforce the glue for each bag's attachment. Insert stapler in center, about two inches down, so that it does not affect your snowflake design.








Step Four: Fold bags into a single pile again. Draw out snowflake's design on top bag. Get creative! Once drawn, cut along lines through all bags. *Note: Do not cut on bottom of stack where bags are glued together.*

Do not cut here.

Step Five: Fan out snowflake slowly and connect top and bottom bags with multiple staples to hold open. Make a hole (using scissors or hole punch) about an inch down where two bags meet. This designates the top. Use twine to create a hanger for snowflake. All done!
