

Back-to-school APPLES

Supply List:

- Red & green tissue paper
- Glue stick
- Twine
- Cardboard
- Toilet paper rolls (2)
- Scissors
- Twig



Step One: Glue red tissue paper to toilet paper roll. Tissue paper can be flat or crumpled - artist's choice! Cut off excess tissue paper.

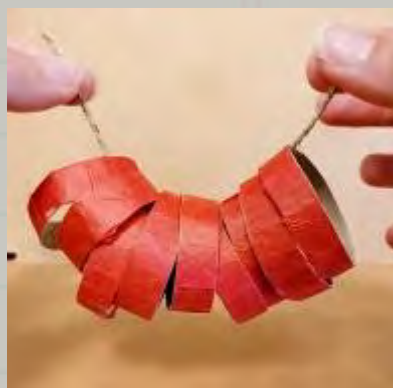


Step Two: Cut roll into $\frac{1}{2}$ " rings - should have space for nine.



Continued on back...

Step Three: Thread the twine through the rings and knot tightly. Fan out the rings evenly to make the body of your apple.



Step Four: Insert twig through center of apple, dab some glue to keep it in place. Cut out a leaf from your scrap cardboard. Adhere the green tissue paper to both sides and trim. Either tuck, or glue, the leaf into place by the stem.
