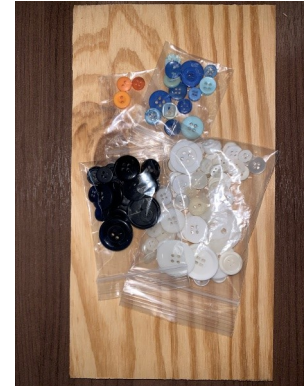


Snowman Button Art



Supplies included:

Painted OR unpainted board
White buttons
Black buttons
Blue buttons
Orange buttons

Additional supplies needed:

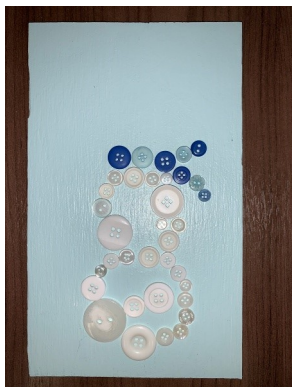
Paint or stain for unpainted board
Paint brush
Hot glue gun
Glue sticks

Step 1

Paint or stain the board if your kit includes an unpainted board. If you like to paint, create a snow scene with trees. Be creative!

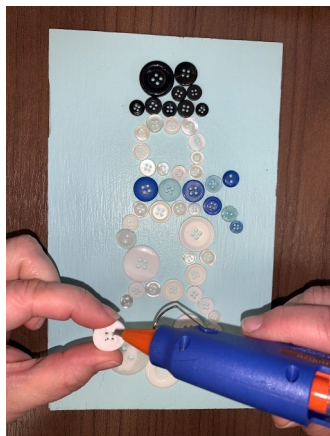
Step 2

Start laying out the buttons on the board by creating two circles of white buttons for the body about 1/2 inch from the bottom center of the board. DO NOT GLUE ANY BUTTONS AT THIS POINT. Lay the blue buttons above your two circles to create a scarf. Add another circle of white buttons above the scarf for the snowman's head. Above the head, place a row of black buttons for the hat brim. Then add more black buttons for the top hat.



Step 3

So far none of the buttons have been glued down. If you like how your snowman is looking, attach the buttons with a hot glue gun. This will get messy and stringy!!



Step 4

Once your buttons are attached to the board, add more! Use ALL of the white, blue & black buttons in the kit! Layer the buttons on top of each other.
